II. Christmas Dinner Review

- Sold 72 tickets, with total expenditure of £386. This is good for the budget as we initially budgeted £1000 for the 'Big Three Events'; Xmas Dinner, hall trip and Coming Down Dinner.

III. Amsterdam Update

- 46 tickets at cost price of £79.74. Earlybird tickets selling at £65 until the 1st Jan. After that date, tickets will return to cost price and will be open to Gabor and +1s
- Hostel (Clink Noord) is a 5 minute ferry ride from Amsterdam city centre. Ferries are free, operating 24/7 and running every 7 minutes. Other option was Slotania which was only £2 cheaper and was a 30 minute tram ride away.
- Itinerary is a WIP (work in progress). We could make some tourist packs with suggested events or maybe organise a group activity on one day for those that are interested.
- Event poster to be made and displayed around hall. Need to have a lot of advertisement this week whilst people are around before the holidays, then continued posting over Xmas to keep interest high. Itinerary post will be a key generator, plus tourist videos etc.
